The Catholic Church exists "in order to evangelize" (Pope Paul VI). Yet, many Catholics believe making disciples is the work of clergy and religious or they fear offending others when they share their faith. Marcel LeJeune's presentation "Catholic Evangelization: Fear Not" will inspire and instruct Catholics to be better witnesses to Christ and the truths of the Catholic Church to family, friends, and our modern culture.

Marcel LeJeune is the Assistant Director of Campus Ministry at the largest campus ministry in the country, St. Mary's Catholic Center at Texas A&M University. This dynamic campus ministry has 4,000-6,000 college students attend Mass on weekends, as well as thousands involved in programs outside of Mass.

Marcel is also a popular author and speaker, especially on the topic of evangelization. He has presented to hundreds of groups ranging in size from a few dozen to 4,000. He has been published in *The Catholic Faith* magazine, *CatholicExchange.com*, by the *Catholic News Agency*, has a regular column in *The Catholic Spirit* (Diocese of Austin) on evangelization, and has written a book on evangelization titled *The Catholic Evangelist: Fear Not*.

He holds a Master of Theological Studies, specializing in Pastoral Theology, from Ave Maria University and a Bachelor's degree from Texas A&M University. During the beginning of undergraduate years, he fell away from the Church, but was evangelized by other Catholics and brought back to the Church. During his graduate studies he felt a call to spread the truth of the Catholic faith to individuals and groups in an effective way. This call has led him to start new and innovative programs of evangelization that lead many others into (or back into) the Catholic Church.
